Roche Young Scientist Award (RYSA) invites all secondary school students in Hong Kong to present their scientific research, invention or discovery that will improve the well-being of the people in our community.

RYSA aims to shine a spotlight on the importance of innovation and science education, and uncover the science talent of secondary school students in Hong Kong.

- RYSA 2013 Champion team won the first RYSA with an economic and effective device designed to help students with dyslexia learn more effectively.
- RYSA 2015 Champion team invented a self-disinfecting door handle that kills germs with UV light.

Interact with university science students


Eligibility & Criteria

- The competition is open to all secondary school students in Hong Kong.
- Each team must consist of three students.
- Each student can join one team only.
- Every member of the team must be from the same school.
- Each team can submit one project only.














Steps to Enter



- 1. **Read** the information on RYSA website (<u>www.rysa.com.hk</u>) to understand the competition requirements.
- 2. **Register** your team on the website (<u>www.rysa.com.hk</u>) and create a login name and password*.
- 3. **Submit** a video of up to three minutes in length by noon, 6 January 2017.
 - The video should include a brief overview, hypothesis, methodology, results / supporting evidence and conclusion, in a WMV/MP4/MOV file format and less than 50MB in size.
 - The video can be in Cantonese or English.
 - The video can be revised and uploaded again before the submission due date.

Awards & Prizes


Each award will be given to one winning team, except 'Supporting Science in School Award'.

The top 3 schools with the highest number of teams entered in the competition will be rewarded with the 'Supporting Science in School Award'.
